## **Revision Technique:**

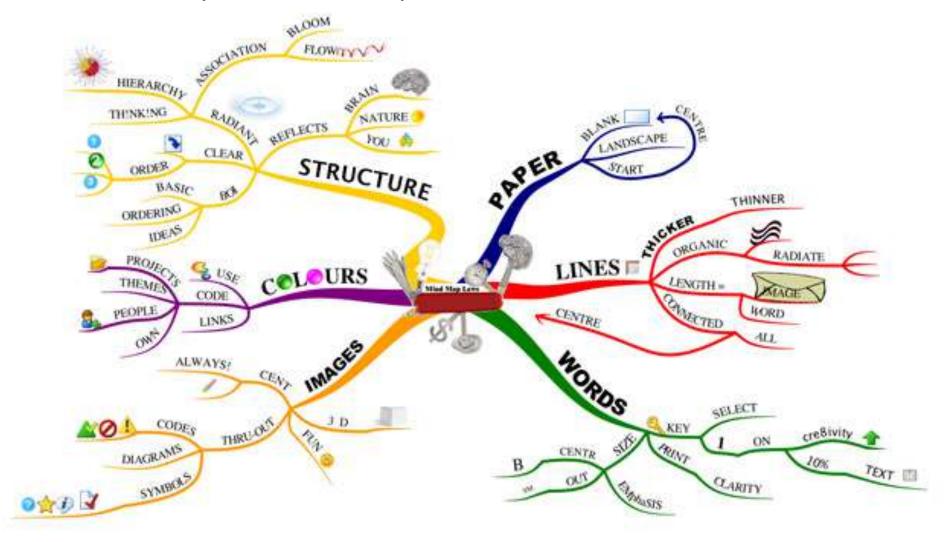
'Graphic Organisers'

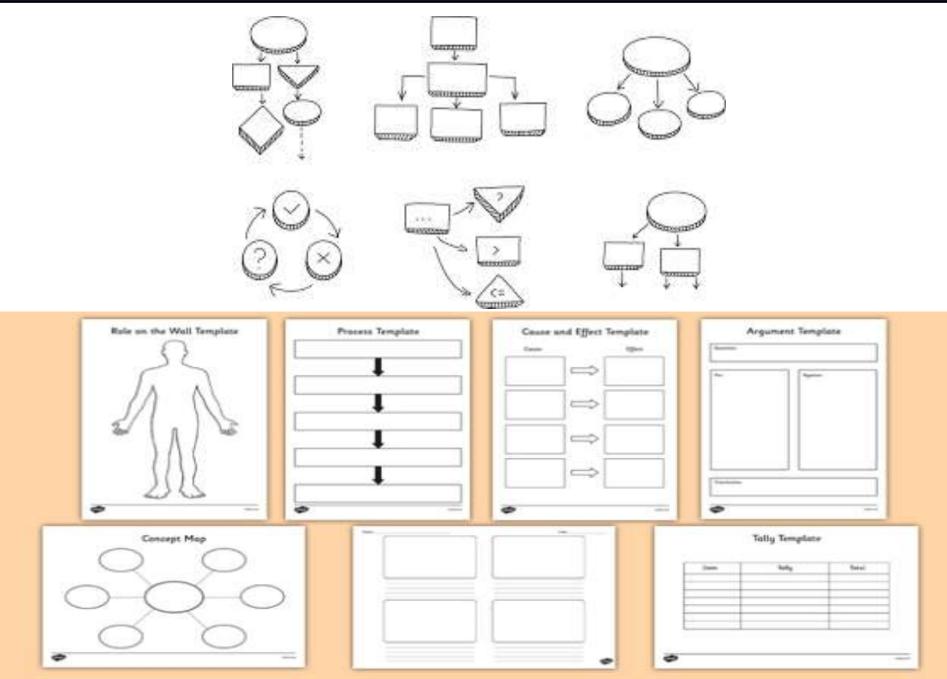
What are they? A visual representation of information. It is the process and not the end product that is important!

## **Revision Technique:**

## 'Dual Coding'

What is it? Dual coding is the use of a combination of pictures/visuals and words to help you learn material.

**Purpose:** By transferring revision material into a different form, you strengthen connections in your brain. You are giving yourself multiple formats for recall - words might act as a memory cue for visuals, or you might remember visuals and that will trigger the memory of words.

#### Your revision task:

Aim to use dual coding on your graphic organiser.
