Key Stage 5

We offer a range of Level 3 Advanced Level courses (10 hours each per fortnight), as well as support lessons.

Students entering the Sixth Form to study our academic route must have a minimum of 5 grade 9-5 GCSE grades, which must include a grade 5 or above in either English Language or English Literature. In addition, the minimum subject entry criteria must be met.

Students entering the Sixth Form to study our full-time vocational route must have a minimum of 4 grade 9-5 GCSE grades, which must include a grade 4 or above in either English Language or English Literature and Mathematics. In addition, the minimum subject entry criteria must be met.

Any student entering the Sixth Form without a grade 4 or above in GCSE Maths must retake the qualification. Any student studying an A level science subject but not A level Maths, must attend Numeracy in Science which is a support lesson. Any student identified as underachieving will attend the Study Support sessions. If a student does not study any of the subjects in an option block, they have independent study. Any student identified as underachieving will attend the Study Support sessions. If a student does not study any of the subjects in an option block, they have independent study.

Students entering the Sixth Form to study our vocational route must have a minimum of 5 grade 9-4 GCSE grades, which must include a grade 4 or above in either English Language or English Literature and a 4 or above in Maths. In addition, the minimum subject entry criteria must be met.
