It might mean stepping in to help juggle childcare, providing a listening ear to a struggling teen, or calling the NSPCC Helpline if you think a child is at risk.

Our Listen up, Speak up workshop explores:

- the signs a child might be at risk, and steps you can take to help
- how to approach difficult conversations to help keep children safe
- who you can contact if you're ever concerned about a child or their family.

We can deliver an hour-long workshop at your workplace, school, club or community group during the week of 11-15 November. The workshop is free of charge and anyone aged 18+ is welcome to attend. Bookings will operate on a first-come, first-served basis.
