Here at Wood Green Academy, we believe that the quality of our curriculum is fundamental to the achievement and enjoyment of our students.

Every individual student's needs are paramount to us. At our "foundation" stage, students follow a broad range of subjects and a comprehensive enrichment programme. There is no barrier at our "specialist" stage when it comes to choosing options: we are truly inclusive. Our programme includes academic and vocational courses offering everything from science to sport, maths to media.

We believe that it is not only what goes on in the classroom but outside that helps shape our students.

As Ofsted noted "The school ensures pupils receive an ambitious curriculum."

For students to be truly successful and happy, they need to develop an "I Can, I Will" attitude. As an Academy, we have invested in teaching strategies, leadership roles and wider opportunities to support the students to develop seven key attributes. These are: resilience, risk-taking, reflectiveness, curiosity, flexibility of mind, drive and initiative. In Years 7 and 8, students record where they have demonstrated these attributes in and out of school, and can earn their bronze, silver and gold awards.

Through these experiences, students leave Wood Green with the confidence to lead, the compassion to care and the skills to thrive in their future lives.

















We are extremely proud of our team of staff. We know that a school could not operate without the vital role played by our teachers and support staff. We value all our staff and they are totally dedicated to providing the best environment possible for our students.

Our staff are devoted, hardworking and genuinely care for our students. This was celebrated by Ofsted in April 2025 who commented that: "Pupils in all years, including students in the sixth form, talk of positive relationships with staff, several of whom attended the school themselves. Our teaching staff are subject specialists who hold degrees in their subject areas. All teachers also participate in weekly professional development sessions to ensure that their subject knowledge is kept fresh, and that they are abreast of all the latest research in terms of the best ways to teach, and the best ways to support students to learn.

Teachers at Wood Green Academy are continually updating their own professional knowledge to benefit our students. We have staff training every week to ensure that the education we provide is always challenging, engaging and a combination of proven best practice with up-to-date innovation. Such is our reputation, we are involved in a huge number of schemes for sharing our best practice and expertise with other schools, colleges, universities, and educationalists who want to know the secrets of our success.
