CHRISTMAS CACTUS

DESPITE THE NAME THESE BEAUTIFUL CACTI WILL BLOOM DURING DARK, LONGER NIGHTS, OFTEN AROUND CHRISTMAS. HOWEVER IN THE SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE JULY IS IN WINTER! WHICH MEANS THEIR BEAUTIFUL FLOWERS WILL BE IN FULL BLOOM.

FLOWERING KALANCHOE

THESE WONDERFUL SUCCULENTS WILL BLOOM IN HIGH SUN WHICH IS OFTEN DURING IN THE BRIGHT SUMMER MONTHS SUCH AS JULY. SO PLACE THEM ON YOUR WINDOW SILL AND WAIT FOR MIDDAY AND SEE IF YOU CAN CATCH A BUD BLOOMING!
